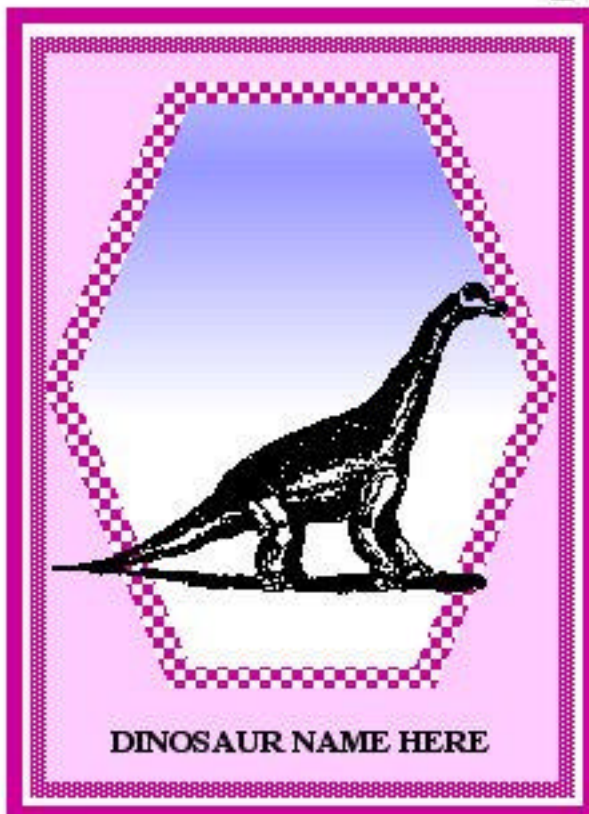

**Special Features:**

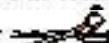

**What it Ate:** small animals & tender plants

The pterosaurs were the first noninsect animals to develop flapping flight. Evidence suggests that some pterosaurs were partially warm-blooded. Pterosaurs flew in prehistoric skies beginning in the Triassic Period and continuing through the Jurassic Period until their extinction at the end of the Cretaceous Period along with most other dinosaurs.
